St. Michiel Single Mooring Buoy

St. Michiel's Bay is located on Curaçao's southern coast, 8 km west of the capital Willemstad. It offers a sheltered deep bay with clear and safe waters, making it suitable for (long-term) lay-up and service calls. It is ideal for carrying out underwater services and minor repairs. Vessels with dangerous cargoes can also be anchored here. The many benefits for shipowners include: availability of maintenance and repair supplies and companies, attractive harbor rates, and close proximity to the shore.

Facility/Service	Details
Mooring Buoy (SMB):	Located 198 m offshore at a depth of 39.6 m. The buoy is 2.7 m high and 5.48 m wide. It is chained to two shore anchors with two 120 mm stud link chains, and has two hooks to tie up the vessel. It is equipped with a load monitor. Max. DWT is 350,000.
Repair and Maintenance:	Repairs can be performed using barges from Willemstad.
Cargo Facilities:	Lighters can transfer cargo (limited amounts)
Bunker Service:	Fuel and fresh water can be supplied from Willemstad by barge
Ballast/slop reception:	Available by barge
Other services:	A range of marine services can be provided at the facility, including fumigation, waste management, tug services, barges, underwater services, and more
